

DISTORTING, SKEW, TWIST, TWISTED, TWISTING, TWISTY

David said that people **twisted** his words every day. (In other words, they used his words against him in deceptive and evil ways.)

- **Psalm 56:5:** "Every day they wrest my words: all their thoughts are against me for evil."

When people **twisted** David's words, he cried out to God and asked Him to judge them.

- **Psalm 56:5-7:** "Every day they wrest my words: all their thoughts are against me for evil. They gather themselves together, they hide themselves, they mark my steps, when they wait for my soul. Shall they escape by iniquity? in thine anger cast down the people, O God."

The path of an immoral woman is a dangerous and **twisty** road that leads to death and hell.

- **Proverbs 5:5-6:** "Her feet go down to death; her steps take hold on hell. Lest thou shouldest ponder the path of life, her ways are moveable, that thou canst not know them."

Being hungry can **skew** your judgment. It can make it difficult to see things as they really are.

- **Proverbs 27:7:** "The full soul loatheth an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is sweet."

Twisting the nose produces blood.

- **Proverbs 30:33:** "Surely the churning of milk bringeth forth butter, and the wringing of the nose bringeth forth blood: so the forcing of wrath bringeth forth strife."

The Israelites treated burning incense to God as if they were blessing an idol. They **twisted** worship into something perverse.

- **Isaiah 66:3:** "He that killeth an ox is as if he slew a man; he that sacrificeth a lamb, as if he cut off a dog's neck; he that offereth an oblation, as if he offered swine's blood; he that burneth incense, as if he blessed an idol. Yea, they have chosen their own ways, and their soul delighteth in their abominations."

There are times when the devil tempts people by **twisting** what the Word of God has to say.

- **Luke 4:9-12:** "And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down from hence: For it is written, He shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee: And in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone. And Jesus answering said unto him, It is said, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God."

The Jews tried to enforce their **twisted** interpretation of God's Sabbath laws by killing people.

- **John 5:16:** "And therefore did the Jews persecute Jesus, and sought to slay him, because he had done these things on the sabbath day."

One of the ways false witnesses tell lies about the church is by **distorting** what the word of God actually teaches.

- **Acts 6:14:** "For we have heard him say, that this Jesus of Nazareth shall destroy this place, and shall change the customs which Moses delivered us."

Those who are defiled are unable to see purity anywhere. Instead they condemn things that are good and **twist** them into something awful.

- **Titus 1:15:** "Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled."
