

# INDWELT

If a demon is cast out of someone, and that person is never saved and **indwelt** with the Holy Spirit, then that person's body is empty from the demon's perspective.

- **Matthew 12:43-44:** "When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished."

The way to protect ourselves from being possessed by demons is by being **indwelt** by the Holy Spirit. (It's impossible for Christians to become demon possessed. No one can be filled with both the Holy Spirit and an unholy spirit at the same time.)

- **Matthew 12:43-45:** "When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished. Then goeth he, and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation."

People who aren't saved are vulnerable to demon-possession. Since they're not **indwelt** with the Holy Spirit, there's nothing stopping a demon from moving in and taking up residence inside them.

- **Luke 11:24-26:** "When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished. Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first."

If a demon is cast out of someone, but that person is never saved and **indwelt** with the Holy Spirit, then that demon will return.

- **Luke 11:24-25:** "When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. And when he cometh, he findeth it swept and garnished."

If a demon is cast out of someone, and that person is never saved and **indwelt** with the Holy Spirit, then casting out the demon will make things *much worse*. This is because in the end he will be possessed by even more spirits than he was previously, and the new spirits will be more wicked than the one who was cast out.

- **Luke 11:26:** "Then goeth he, and taketh to him seven other spirits more wicked than himself; and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first."
