

SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY

It seems that in the Day of the Lord (the tribulation era), modern **technology** won't exist. People will wage war with ancient weapons.

- **Isaiah 13:18:** "Their bows also shall dash the young men to pieces; and they shall have no pity on the fruit of the womb; their eyes shall not spare children."

It seems that at the beginning of the millennium, modern **technology** won't exist. Instead people will travel around by riding on animals.

- **Isaiah 66:20:** "And they shall bring all your brethren for an offering unto the LORD out of all nations upon horses, and in chariots, and in litters, and upon mules, and upon swift beasts, to my holy mountain Jerusalem, saith the LORD, as the children of Israel bring an offering in a clean vessel into the house of the LORD."

Nebuchadnezzar wanted his servants to have a good understanding of **science**.

- **Daniel 1:4:** "Children in whom was no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans."

Daniel and his three friends (Hananiah, Mishaël, and Azariah)

met the qualifications to be one of Nebuchanezzar's servants. That means they were handsome, had no physical flaws, were wise, were cunning, were filled with knowledge, and understood **science**. They were also the sort of people who could serve in the palace.

- **Daniel 1:6:** "Now among these were of the children of Judah, Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah:"

In the tribulation era, it seems that modern **technology** won't exist. Nations will wage war with ancient weapons.

- **Daniel 11:40:** "And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over."

It seems that the battle described in Zechariah 9 will take place in a world that doesn't have modern **technology**. The Jews will fight against the Greeks using stones, which are very primitive weapons.

- **Zechariah 9:15:** "The LORD of hosts shall defend them; and they shall devour, and subdue with sling stones; and they shall drink, and make a noise as through wine; and they shall be filled like bowls, and as the corners of the altar."

When the prophecy found in Zechariah 10 takes place, modern **technology** won't exist. That war will be fought with riders upon horses, instead of with modern weapons. The streets will also be made of dirt and will be full of mire.

- **Zechariah 10:5:** "And they shall be as mighty men, which tread down their enemies in the mire of the streets in the battle: and they shall fight, because the LORD is with them, and the riders on horses shall be confounded."

It seems that in the tribulation era, wars will be fought with ancient weapons (such as horses). Modern **technology** won't exist in those days.

- **Zechariah 12:4:** "In that day, saith the LORD, I will smite every horse with astonishment, and his rider with madness: and I will open mine eyes upon the house of Judah, and will smite every horse of the people with blindness."

When nations come against Jerusalem in the tribulation era, they'll be fighting with ancient weapons and riding animals. It seems they won't have access to modern weapons or modern **technology**.

- **Zechariah 14:15:** "And so shall be the plague of the horse, of the mule, of the camel, and of the ass, and of all the beasts that shall be in these tents, as this plague."

In the millennium, it seems that modern **technology** won't exist. Instead people will ride around on horses.

- **Zechariah 14:20:** "In that day shall there be upon the bells of the horses, HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD; and the pots in the LORD's house shall be like the bowls before the altar."

When Jesus returns at the end of the tribulation, it seems that modern **technology** won't exist. People will be grinding grain at a mill instead of using machinery to do it.

- **Matthew 24:41:** "Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left."

Paul spoke of oppositions to the Scriptures that were being made on the basis of false **science**.

- **1 Timothy 6:20:** "O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:"

It seems that modern **technology** is lost before the end times, and isn't recovered. At the end of the tribulation society is still primitive, and works on ancient terms. (For example, people are using chariots to move around.)

- **Revelation 18:13:** "And cinnamon, and odours, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men."

In the tribulation, fine linen and purple linen and scarlet linen are considered to be on the same level as gold and precious stones. This is more evidence that modern **technology** doesn't exist in those days. The end times world will value the same things that a pre-technology society values.

- **Revelation 18:12:** "The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most

precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,"

- **Revelation 18:16:** "And saying, Alas, alas that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!"

It seems that in the end times there will be millstones in Babylon. This is more evidence that modern **technology** won't exist in the tribulation era, because millstones will be used to grind grain (instead of modern machinery.)

- **Revelation 18:22:** "And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters, shall be heard no more at all in thee; and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in thee; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in thee;"

Since the great and wealthy city of Babylon is lit by candles, this is more evidence that modern **technology** won't exist in the tribulation era. It seems that modern electric lighting isn't around anymore, and primitive candles are used instead.

- **Revelation 18:23:** "And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in thee; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in thee: for thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived."

The battle of Armageddon will be fought with horses. This is more evidence that modern **technology** won't exist during the tribulation period.

- **Revelation 19:18:** "That ye may eat the flesh of kings, and

the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of them that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great."
