When the temple was dedicated, Solomon said that God kept his promise that a **son of David** would build the temple.

- **1 Kings 8:20:** "And the LORD hath performed his word that he spake, and I am risen up in the room of David my father, and sit on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built an house for the name of the LORD God of Israel."
- **2 Chronicles 6:10:** "The LORD therefore hath performed his word that he hath spoken: for I am risen up in the room of David my father, and am set on the throne of Israel, as the LORD promised, and have built the house for the name of the LORD God of Israel."

Daniel was a **son of David**. He was born in Hebron. (It seems this is the same person as "Chileab" in 2 Samuel 3:2.)

- **1 Chronicles 3:1:** "Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:"

Nogah was a **son of David**.

- **1 Chronicles 3:7:** "And Nogah, and Nepheg, and Japhia,"

God said that He would establish the throne of the **son of David** forever. (This seems to be a Messianic reference.)

- **1 Chronicles 17:11-12:** "And it shall come to pass, when thy days be expired that thou must go to be with thy fathers, that I will raise up thy seed after thee, which shall

be of thy sons; and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build me an house, and I will stablish his throne for ever."

- **1 Chronicles 17:14:** "But I will settle him in mine house and in my kingdom for ever: and his throne shall be established for evermore."

God said that the **son of David** would build a house for Him. (This seems to be a Messianic reference.)

Jerimoth was a son of David.

- **2 Chronicles 11:18:** "And Rehoboam took him Mahalath the daughter of Jerimoth the son of David to wife, and Abihail the daughter of Eliab the son of Jesse;"

The book of Ecclesiastes was written by a **son of David** (Solomon).

- **Ecclesiastes 1:1:** "The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king in Jerusalem."

Jesus is the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 1:1:** "The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham."

An angel of the Lord told Joseph that he was a **son of David**.

- **Matthew 1:20:** "But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the LORD appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost."

The blind men called Jesus the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 9:27:** "And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou son of David, have mercy on us."

When Jesus cast a demon out of someone who was blind and couldn't speak, people believed it was a sign that Jesus was the **son of David** (a title of the Messiah).

- **Matthew 12:22-23:** "Then was brought unto him one possessed with a devil, blind, and dumb: and he healed him, insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw. And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?"

The Canaanite woman called Jesus the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 15:22:** "And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil."

The two blind men called Jesus the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 20:30:** "And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David."
- **Matthew 20:31:** "And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, thou son of David."

During the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, the multitudes called Jesus the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 21:9:** "And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David; Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest."

During the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, there were children in the temple who were saying "Hosanna to the **son of David**".

- **Matthew 21:15:** "And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,"

When the children in the temple said "Hosanna to the **son of David**", they were fulfilling a Messianic prophecy.

- **Matthew 21:15-16:** "And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased, And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?"

The Pharisees told Jesus that the Messiah was the **son of David**.

- **Matthew 22:42:** "Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose

son is he? They say unto him, The son of David."

The fact that David called the Messiah his "Lord" meant the Messiah had to be greater than just a **son of David**. The Messiah had to be divine (which Jesus was), because otherwise David wouldn't worship Him.

- **Matthew 22:45:** "If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?"
- **Mark 12:37:** "David therefore himself calleth him Lord; and whence is he then his son? And the common people heard him gladly."
- **Luke 20:44:** "David therefore calleth him Lord, how is he then his son?"

When Jesus asked the Pharisees how the Messiah could be the **son of David** if David called him "Lord", no one asked him any more questions from that day forward.

- **Matthew 22:45-46:** "If David then call him Lord, how is he his son? And no man was able to answer him a word, neither durst any man from that day forth ask him any more questions."

Bartimaeus called Jesus the **son of David** (which was a Messianic reference).

- **Mark 10:47:** "And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me."

The scribes taught that the Messiah was the **son of David**.

- **Mark 12:35:** "And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David?"

When the blind man called out to Jesus, he called Him the **son of David** (a Messianic term).

- **Luke 18:38:** "And he cried, saying, Jesus, thou son of David, have mercy on me."
- **Luke 18:39:** "And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou son of David, have mercy on me."
