

SON OF MAN

Asaph prayed that the hand of God would be upon the **son of man** whom He made strong for Himself. (This may be a Messianic reference.)

- **Psalm 80:17:** "Let thy hand be upon the man of thy right hand, upon the son of man whom thou madest strong for thyself."

God called Ezekiel the **Son of man**.

- **Ezekiel 2:1:** "And he said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee."

That the **Son of man** and the Ancient of days aren't the same person. (The Son of Man is the Lord Jesus Christ, and the Ancient of Days is God the Father.)

- **Daniel 7:13:** "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him."

When the **Son of man** (Jesus) came, He came with the clouds of heaven.

The kingdom and dominion of the **Son of man** (Jesus) won't be destroyed. It's an everlasting dominion.

- **Daniel 7:13-14:** "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed."

The Ancient of days (God the Father) decreed that all people, nations, and languages should serve the **Son of man** (Jesus).

- **Daniel 7:13-14:** "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom that which shall not be destroyed."

The Ancient of days (God the Father) gave glory to the **Son of man** (Jesus).

- **Daniel 7:14:** "I saw in the night visions, and, behold, one like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him. And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom

that which shall not be destroyed."

Gabriel called Daniel a **son of man**.

- **Daniel 8:17:** "So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand, O son of man: for at the time of the end shall be the vision."

Jesus said there were some people standing there who wouldn't die until they saw the **Son of man** come in His kingdom. (In every case, this statement was said right before His transfiguration, which seems to be the fulfillment of that promise.)

- **Matthew 16:28:** "Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom."

At the end of the seven-year tribulation, after the sun and moon are darkened and the stars fall, the sign of the **Son of man** will appear in heaven.

- **Matthew 24:29-30:** "Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."

In the end times, the whole world will recognize the sign of the **Son of man** in heaven and will understand that it means that Jesus is about to return.

- **Matthew 24:30:** "And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."

At the end of the seven-year tribulation, after the sign of the **Son of man** (Jesus) appears in heaven, all the tribes of the earth will see Jesus return.

- **Matthew 24:30:** "And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory."

The **Son of man** (Jesus) is Lord of the Sabbath.

- **Mark 2:28:** "Therefore the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath."
- **Luke 6:5:** "And he said unto them, That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath."

Jesus said that the **Son of man** (Jesus) must suffer many things and die.

- **Mark 9:12:** "And he answered and told them, Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all things; and how it is written of the Son of man, that he must suffer many things, and be set at nought."

Jesus told His disciples that one day they would desire to see one of the days of the **Son of man**, but would not see them.

- **Luke 17:22:** "And he said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see it."

Jesus called Himself the **Son of man**.

- **Matthew 8:20:** "And Jesus saith unto him, The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head."
- **Matthew 9:6:** "But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house."
- **Matthew 10:23:** "But when they persecute you in this city, flee ye into another: for verily I say unto you, Ye shall not have gone over the cities of Israel, till the Son of man be come."
- **Matthew 11:19:** "The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is justified of her children."
- **Matthew 12:8:** "For the Son of man is Lord even of the sabbath day."
- **Matthew 12:32:** "And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come."
- **Matthew 12:40:** "For as Jonas was three days and three

nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth."

- **Matthew 13:37:** "He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man;"
- **Matthew 13:41:** "The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity;"
- **Matthew 16:13:** "When Jesus came into the coasts of Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples, saying, Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?"
- **Matthew 16:27:** "For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works."
- **Matthew 16:28:** "Verily I say unto you, There be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Son of man coming in his kingdom."
- **Matthew 17:9:** "And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, until the Son of man be risen again from the dead."
- **Matthew 17:12:** "But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them."
- **Matthew 17:22:** "And while they abode in Galilee, Jesus said unto them, The Son of man shall be betrayed into the hands of men:"
- **Matthew 18:11:** "For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost."
- **Matthew 19:28:** "And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say

unto you, That ye which have followed me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of his glory, ye also shall sit upon twelve thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel."

- **Matthew 20:18:** "Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,"
- **Matthew 20:28:** "Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many."
- **Matthew 24:27:** "For as the lightning cometh out of the east, and shineth even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."
- **Matthew 24:37:** "But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."
- **Matthew 24:44:** "Therefore be ye also ready: for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh."
- **Matthew 25:13:** "Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh."
- **Matthew 25:31:** "When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:"
- **Matthew 26:2:** "Ye know that after two days is the feast of the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified."
- **Matthew 26:24:** "The Son of man goeth as it is written of him: but woe unto that man by whom the Son of man is betrayed! it had been good for that man if he had not been born."
- **Matthew 26:45:** "Then cometh he to his disciples, and

saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: behold, the hour is at hand, and the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners."

- **Matthew 26:64:** "Jesus saith unto him, Thou hast said: nevertheless I say unto you, Hereafter shall ye see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven."
- **Mark 2:10:** "But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,)"
- **Mark 8:31:** "And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and of the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again."
- **Mark 8:38:** "Whosoever therefore shall be ashamed of me and of my words in this adulterous and sinful generation; of him also shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he cometh in the glory of his Father with the holy angels."
- **Mark 10:33:** "Saying, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles:"
- **Mark 13:26:** "And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory."
- **Mark 13:34:** "For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left his house, and gave authority to his servants, and to every man his work, and commanded the porter to watch."
- **Mark 14:21:** "The Son of man indeed goeth, as it is written of him: but woe to that man by whom the Son of

man is betrayed! good were it for that man if he had never been born."

- **Mark 14:41:** "And he cometh the third time, and saith unto them, Sleep on now, and take your rest: it is enough, the hour is come; behold, the Son of man is betrayed into the hands of sinners."
- **Mark 14:62:** "And Jesus said, I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven."
- **Luke 5:24:** "But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to forgive sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house."
- **Luke 6:22:** "Blessed are ye, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake."
- **Luke 7:34:** "The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and ye say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners!"
- **Luke 9:22:** "Saying, The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day."
- **Luke 9:44:** "Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men."
- **Luke 9:56:** "For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to save them. And they went to another village."
- **Luke 9:58:** "And Jesus said unto him, Foxes have holes,

and birds of the air have nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay his head."

- **Luke 11:30:** "For as Jonas was a sign unto the Ninevites, so shall also the Son of man be to this generation."
- **Luke 12:8:** "Also I say unto you, Whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God:"
- **Luke 12:10:** "And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven."
- **Luke 12:40:** "Be ye therefore ready also: for the Son of man cometh at an hour when ye think not."
- **Luke 17:22:** "And he said unto the disciples, The days will come, when ye shall desire to see one of the days of the Son of man, and ye shall not see it."
- **Luke 17:24:** "For as the lightning, that lighteneth out of the one part under heaven, shineth unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in his day."
- **Luke 17:26:** "And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man."
- **Luke 17:30:** "Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed."
- **Luke 18:8:** "I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?"
- **Luke 18:31:** "Then he took unto him the twelve, and said unto them, Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished."

- **Luke 19:10:** "For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."
- **Luke 21:27:** "And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory."
- **Luke 21:36:** "Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man."
- **Luke 22:22:** "And truly the Son of man goeth, as it was determined: but woe unto that man by whom he is betrayed!"
- **Luke 22:48:** "But Jesus said unto him, Judas, betrayest thou the Son of man with a kiss?"
- **Luke 22:69:** "Hereafter shall the Son of man sit on the right hand of the power of God."
- **Luke 24:7:** "Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again."
- **John 1:51:** "And he saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man."
- **John 3:13:** "And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven."
- **John 5:27:** "And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man."
- **John 6:27:** "Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed."

- **John 6:62:** "What and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?"
- **John 12:23:** "And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified."
- **John 13:31:** "Therefore, when he was gone out, Jesus said, Now is the Son of man glorified, and God is glorified in him."

In the future, Nathanael would see heaven open and the angels of God ascend and descend upon the **Son of man** (Jesus).

- **John 1:49-51:** "Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the Son of God; thou art the King of Israel. Jesus answered and said unto him, Because I said unto thee, I saw thee under the fig tree, believest thou? thou shalt see greater things than these. And he saith unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Hereafter ye shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man."

The reason God the Father gave Jesus the authority to carry out judgment is because Jesus is the **Son of man**.

- **John 5:27:** "And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man."

The people didn't understand what Jesus meant when He said that the **Son of man** must be lifted up. (It meant Jesus had to be crucified.)

- **John 12:34:** "The people answered him, We have heard

out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how sayest thou, The Son of man must be lifted up? who is this Son of man?"

The people didn't understand who the **Son of man** was. (It was Jesus.)

Stephen called Jesus the **Son of man**.

- **Acts 7:56:** "And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God."

When Stephen was on trial by the religious leaders of Israel, he told them that he saw the **Son of man** standing on the right hand of God.

The apostle John called Jesus the **Son of man**.

- **Revelation 1:13:** "And in the midst of the seven candlesticks one like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle."
