

LIKETH, SUITABLE, SUITED

Since it wasn't good for the first man (Adam) to be alone, God created a helper who was **suitable** for him.

- **Genesis 2:18:** "And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him."

The reason God created the first woman (Eve) was to provide the first man (Adam) with a helper who was **suitable** for him.

- **Genesis 2:18, 21-23:** "And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him. ... And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said, This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man."

No **suitable** helper was found for Adam among the birds of the air, the beasts of the field, or livestock.

- **Genesis 2:20:** "And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him."

Before God created the first woman, He showed Adam that there was no **suitable** helper for him in the animal kingdom.

The land on the east side of the Jordan river was well **suited** for raising cattle. (That's why the tribes of Reuben and Gad wanted to settle there, since they raised cattle.)

- **Numbers 32:1-4:** "Now the children of Reuben and the children of Gad had a very great multitude of cattle: and when they saw the land of Jazer, and the land of Gilead, that, behold, the place was a place for cattle; The children of Gad and the children of Reuben came and spake unto Moses, and to Eleazar the priest, and unto the princes of the congregation, saying, Ataroth, and Dibon, and Jazer, and Nimrah, and Heshbon, and Elealeh, and Shebam, and Nebo, and Beon, Even the country which the LORD smote before the congregation of Israel, is a land for cattle, and thy servants have cattle:"

After King Ahasuerus removed Vashti from being queen, his servants suggested bringing all the beautiful young virgins from the entire kingdom to Shushan the palace, to look for a **suitable** replacement for her.

- **Esther 2:3-4:** "And let the king appoint officers in all the provinces of his kingdom, that they may gather together all the fair young virgins unto Shushan the palace, to the house of the women, unto the custody of Hege the king's chamberlain, keeper of the women; and let their things for purification be given them: And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so."
